

## **GROUP VISITS RISK ASSESSMENT**

At Hatton Adventure World the Health and Safety of our visitors is our number one priority.

Below is our standard Risk Assessment for a visit to the Adventure World. However as every visitor and group has their own particular needs and requirements we strongly advise that groups planning to visit Hatton Adventure World carry out their own risk assessment before their visit.

Hazard or Activity	Risks Associated	Potential to cause Harm	Controls in place and action required by visitors
Animals	Infection Biting	Low	All animals on site are hand picked for their docile nature. When feeding the chickens or pigs the feed should be thrown in and not given by hand. How to feed the animals will be covered during your safety talk. In all animal areas including Scales and Tails only suitable animals will be handled by visitors. Trained staff supervise all animal areas. Your Group Leaders must ensure that children wash their hands after handling the animals and especially before eating or drinking. Please note that wet wipes are not sufficient.
Animal Droppings	Infection	Low	All animals areas are thoroughly cleaned each morning. Public pathways and grassed areas are free from animals.
Animal Handling	Infection	Low/Med	After handling any animals all visitors MUST wash their hands and follow guidance procedures displayed.
Play Area	Falling Tripping	Low	Children must be supervised at all times. All signage for equipment must be adhered to at all times. ROSPA annual inspection.
Indoor Soft Play	Falling Tripping Impact		All soft play rules and guidance procedures displayed must be adhered to. Daily checklist of play area maintained and ROSPA annual inspection. Socks must be worn and arms and legs covered to ride the slides in Snorty's Superslide Mania. Height restrictions apply. Children must not run. This area is staffed accordingly, however your Group Leaders remain fully responsible for the children at all times.
